Campference FAQs

1. Who can attend Campference?

Campference is designed for middle school students (typically grades 6–8). If you have questions about specific age or grade eligibility, please contact us at Camps@parkvalleychurch.com.

2. Is Campference an overnight event?

No, Campference is not an overnight retreat. Students will return home each evening. However, students are welcome to plan their own sleepovers. The schedule is:

• Friday, October 24, 2025: 5:30 PM–10:00 PM (Pickup)

• Saturday, October 25, 2025: 9:30 AM–9:30 PM

• Sunday, October 26, 2025: 9:30 AM-12:00 PM

3. What activities will be included?

Campference includes a mix of fun and engaging activities such as games, worship sessions, small group discussions, breakout groups and teaching focused on faith and discipleship. The event combines the high-energy fun of a camp with the meaningful content of a conference to help students grow spiritually and build community.

4. What does the \$99 cost cover?

The \$99 registration fee covers all activities, materials, and provided meals (Friday dinner, Saturday lunch, and Saturday dinner). Students are responsible for eating breakfast at home before arriving on Saturday and Sunday.

5. What should my student bring?

Students should bring:

- Comfortable clothes for active games and worship sessions
- A Bible
- Personal items like a water bottle or medications
 Please label all belongings to prevent loss. A lost and found will be available during the event.

6. Do students need to bring meals or snacks?

No, meals are provided as follows:

- Friday: Dinner
- Saturday: Lunch and Dinner Students should eat breakfast at home before arriving on Saturday and Sunday. No meals are provided on Sunday, as the event ends at 12:00 PM. Students may bring a water bottle for personal use.

7. How do I register my student?

8. Is there financial assistance available?

9. Who will be supervising the students?

Campference will be supervised by staff and volunteers from Park Valley Church, all of whom have undergone background checks and are committed to ensuring a safe and positive environment for all students.

10. What safety measures are in place?

The safety of your student is our top priority. The event takes place at Park Valley Church's Student Building/Gym and main building, with secure check-in procedures. All activities are supervised by our vetted team, and our Park Valley security team will be present to help keep everyone safe. Additionally, a nurse will be on-site to address any medical needs. 11. Can parents stay or observe during the event?

Campference is designed for students to participate independently to foster community and engagement. Parents are welcome to drop off and pick up their students but are not expected to stay.
