### ACTS 4:17-18 (NLT2)

<sup>17</sup> But to keep them from spreading their propaganda any further, we must warn them not to speak to anyone in Jesus' name again." <sup>18</sup> So they called the apostles back in and commanded them never again to speak or teach in the name of Jesus.

### ZECHARIAH 9:9 (NLT2)

<sup>9</sup> Rejoice, O people of Zion! Shout in triumph, O people of Jerusalem! Look, your king is coming to you. He is righteous and victorious, yet he is humble, riding on a donkey— riding on a donkey's colt.

### MATTHEW 21:1-5 (NLT2)

<sup>1</sup> As Jesus and the disciples approached Jerusalem, they came to the town of Bethphage on the Mount of Olives. Jesus sent two of them on ahead. <sup>2</sup> "Go into the village over there," he said. "As soon as you enter it, you will see a donkey tied there, with its colt beside it. Untie them and bring them to me. <sup>3</sup> If anyone asks what you are doing, just say, 'The Lord needs them,' and he will immediately let you take them." <sup>4</sup> This took place to fulfill the prophecy that said, <sup>5</sup> "Tell the people of Israel, 'Look, your King is coming to you. He is humble, riding on a donkey— riding on a donkey's colt.'"

### MATTHEW 21:9 (NLT2)

<sup>9</sup> Jesus was in the center of the procession, and the people all around him were shouting, "Praise God for the Son of David! Blessings on the one who comes in the name of the LORD! Praise God in highest heaven!"
